YOUNG ADULT VOLUNTEER Program

UCCP in partnership with the PCUSA

This program invited UCCP young adult members (aged 20-30 years old) to serve in church ministries for one year.

Candidates should be an active member of their church and has ideally served in youth leadership roles. They should enjoy the full support of the church, expressed by the church's endorsement from the local church pastor and conference minister.

Program Benefits

Benefits during the year of service include exposure to the various UCCP ministries, skills training, a regular stipend, and program-related transportation costs covered.

We also invite young adults to engage in social issues, commit to self-reflection, listen to those who are being marginalized and learn in a new way. This is an exciting invitation to "a year of service for a lifetime of change."

Requirements for your selection:

- 1) You are available to serve the church from August 01, 2024 – July 31, 2025
- 2) You must be an active member in your home congregation, such as but not limited to serving as a Sunday school teacher, as a youth group leader or others
- 3) You are between 20-30 years old and have finished at least senior high school
- 4) You are willing to serve and work hard when required
- 5) You have the readiness to go through good and difficult times
- 6) You integrate in a community with different cultural backgrounds
